

The **MMRC** is currently involved in eight {8} separate projects at five (5) different parks in Mira Mesa. They are as follows...

MIRA MESA COMMUNITY PARK...

Phase 1...

Construction under way,

Likely completion **1Q/18**

Phases 2 & 3...

Planning should begin later this year and will most likely include facilities such as a new Recreation Center, new Aquatic Center, new Outdoor Basketball Courts, new Gazebo, new Playground, new Wheels Friendly Area, additional Off-Street Parking, etc. Additional community design input meetings may be scheduled.

Estimated completion **2020-2025**

VETERANS MEMORIAL & FLAG POLE...

Restoration/renovation work was substantially completed in time to fly Old Glory" for the **2017 4th of July** celebration.

MADDOX NEIGHBORHOOD PARK...

Maddox Park is being seamlessly merged with the undeveloped park acreage behind Salk School. The 3rd and hopefully final community design input meeting is schedule for Aug. 8th.

Estimated completion **2019-2021**

WALKER NEIGHBORHOOD PARK...

Walker Park is being seamlessly merged with the partially developed playing fields of Wangenheim Middle School. The 2nd community design input meeting was held **June 13th**.

Estimated completion **2019-2021**

CANYON HILLS RESOURCE PARK...

This entirely new park is to be built on 16 acres of land totally within Canyon Hills Open Space. The 2nd community design input meeting is scheduled for **Oct. 10th**.

Estimated completion **2050**

SANDBURG SCHOOL JOINT-USE PARK...

This entirely new park is to be built on the playing fields behind Sandburg School. It is part of the Mayor's new Play-All-Day program and funded by SDUSD. It will not have a physical connection to the existing Sandburg Park. Community design input meetings will be scheduled.
